The Holocaust

- "Holocaust" Greek original meaning:
 "sacrifice by fire"
- Nazi's targeted 6 million Jews
- "THE FINAL SOLUTION": annihilate the Jewish people
- We call it: "GENOCIDE"
- US Holocaust Memorial Museum
 - Memorial to millions murdered in the Holocaust

Others Persecuted

- The Nazi's considered these groups inferior
 - Roma(Gypsies)
 - Slavic people(Poles, Russians and others)
 - The disabled
- Persecuted on political, ideological or behavioral grounds
 - Communists
 - Socialists
 - Jehovah's Witnesses
 - Homosexuals

How prisoners were identified




Chart of Prisoner Markings

Green Habitual Criminal


Red Political Prisoner

- Jehovah's Witnesses were targeted for these reasons:
 - Refused to "Heil Hitler"
 - Refused military service
 - Would not fly Swastika flag on homes
 - Their children refused to join Nazi Youth
 - Refused to stop practicing their faith
- Why were they unique?
 - They had a <u>choice</u>:

SIGN A DECLARATION RENOUNCING THEIR FAITH

I herewith give assurance that I will never again take any part in the activity of the International Bible Students Association. Any person approaching me with the teaching of the Bible Students, or who in any manner reveal their connections with them, I will denounce immediately. All literature from the Bible Students that should be sent to my address I will at once deliver to the nearest police station. |
| 4. I will in the future esteem the laws of the State, especially in the event of war will I, with weapon in hand, defend the fatherland, and join in every way the community of the people. |
| 5.1 have been informed that I will at once be taken again into protective custody if I should act against the declaration given today. |

The Nazi Salute: "Heil Hitler"

- "Heil" in German means "Salvation"
- English translation: "Hitler Saves"
- Jehovah's Witnesses refused this salute, Why?
- They believe Salvation is through Jesus Christ
- The Nazi Salute was a matter of <u>Integrity</u>
- Refusal to salute was a <u>Choice of Integrity</u>
- Even their children refused



Young Ones Choose Integrity

- Simone Arnold
- 11 Years old
- Refused to Heil Hitler
- Expelled from school
- Sent to 're-education' center

- Wolfgang Kusserow
- 20 Years old
- Refused induction into the army
- Beheaded by guillotine





The Campaign Against Them


- 1933: Police occupied their offices and printing sites
- 1934: Witnesses send letter to the government explaining their beliefs and political neutrality
- 1935: They are officially banned by law
- 1936: 400 imprisoned at Sachsenhausen concentration camp
- 1936: Gestapo agents infiltrate Bible study meetings
- 1939: An estimated 6,000 Witnesses in camps

Response to efforts to destroy them and others

- 1934: Official letter to German government explaining beliefs and neutrality
- 1936: A resolution is adopted condemning the Nazi regime on an international scale
- The resolution and other literature brought into Germany:
 - Indicted the Third Reich
 - Denounced persecution of:
 - German Jews, Nazi savagery toward Communists, remilitarization of Germany, Nazification of schools, Nazi propaganda and the regime's assault on mainstream churches

They Spoke Out

- Detailed descriptions of camps were published in Jehovah's Witness publications
- Their magazine,
 Consolation presented
 sketches of the camps
- By 1940, 20 different camps had been reported
- Conditions and experimentations were reported
